HOW TO USE THIS PATTERN

I designed this pattern to use with just about any other Shiny Happy World pattern.

The letters are very simple and easy to outline for machine appliqué. They're on the skinny side, so you can make 5 and 6 letter words in a single block. Six letters will be pushing it a bit, but I designed the letters with a very irregular, loose, hand-cut look so you can easily slice a little sliver off the thickness of some of the letters to better squish them (if needed) into a 10 inch block.

If you want to resize the letters, <u>this post has instructions</u>. Be sure to check out the comments where people have suggested other programs as well.

Use the regular orientation pages for needle-turn appliqué or tracing to use with all kinds of craft projects.

Use the reversed letters for appliqué with fusible adhesive.

This post has everything you need to know about how to appliqué with fusible adhesive.

<u>This post shows several different layout possibilities that you can use with any Shiny</u> <u>Happy World pattern</u> - including several layouts with added words.

<u>This post has detailed information about the cutting and trimming sizes for half-blocks</u>, which is what I usually use for adding words.

SVG FILES

If you have an electric cutting machine, the easiest file type for you to use is SVG. That's included here!

Click <u>here</u> to find the SVG file for all the letters and numbers, then click the download icon (the arrow pointing down) to download it to your computer.

The image is NOT reversed. If your cutting machine has you cut your pieces fabric side up, leave the orientation as it is. If your cutting machine has you cut your pieces fabric side down, you'll need to flip the image horizontally.

Different cutting machine brands import the image at what seems to be totally random sizes. To fit a standard 5 x 10 inch half block, resize so that your tallest capital letters are 4 inches tall. You can ungroup the pieces after you resize them.
